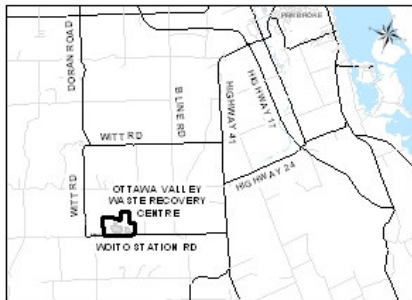




**NOTICE OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT SUBMISSION  
PROPOSED EXPANSION OF THE ALICE & FRASER LANDFILL AT THE  
OTTAWA VALLEY WASTE RECOVERY CENTRE  
TOWNSHIP OF LAURENTIAN VALLEY, ONTARIO**

An Environmental Assessment has been submitted to the Ministry of the Environment by the Township of Laurentian Valley for the expansion of the Alice & Fraser Landfill located near Pembroke, Ontario. The Landfill currently receives, and will continue to receive, solid non-hazardous waste and is operated by the Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery Centre (OVWRC). The expansion being sought is for a 25 to 40 year planning period and the site will receive approximately 750,000 cubic metres over the first 25 years and 490,000 cubic metres over the remaining 15 years. The site is currently operating under an Emergency Certificate of Approval until such time that the approval process is complete. The Alice & Fraser Landfill is part of an integrated waste management system run by the OVWRC and is the last component of the system which also includes a material recovery facility, a centralized composting facility, an outdoor composting area, a construction and demolition waste recovery area, a permanent household hazardous waste depot and a waste oil transfer station. The service area for the Landfill was increased on November 29, 2001, to include Renfrew County, the City of Pembroke, Canadian Forces Base Petawawa and Algonquin Park.



This Environmental Assessment is being submitted to the Ministry of the Environment for formal review as required under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*, Section 6.2(1), and in accordance with the Terms of Reference approved by the Minister of the Environment on May 28, 1999.
